FREDERIKSVÆRK

The Town of Bridges

Three hundred years ago, a major channel was dug from Denmark's biggest lake Arresø to Roskilde Fjord to prevent the reoccurring floods which the farmers around Arresø suffered from often. Today, the channels of Frederiksværk bear witness to the town's intriguing industrial history, and the beautiful surroundings of the canal are a defining characteristic of Frederiksværk, adding something unique to the town.

Bridges are essential in order to arrive dryshod from one side of the canal to the other – and indeed, you will find bridges all over Frederiksværk. Some bridges are old, some are new. Some are big, others are smaller. Some of them have names, while others are nameless. In total, 25 bridges cross the canals of Frederiksværk.

Are you up for a little exercise? Count all the bridges you have crossed during your tour of Frederiksværk. Have you reached 25? If not, there is plenty more of Frederiksværk to be explored.

One of the main features of Frederiksværk town is the winding canal that connects Denmark's largest lake, Arresø, to Roskilde Fjord. The water flows slowly through the town, bringing nature into the urban environment. The canal has always been the pulse of the town, already providing energy to the local industry back in the 1700s. Enjoy a break in one of the town's picturesque squares: the charming Nordtorv, the new Valsetorv or on the grassy area in front of the Cultural Centre Gjethuset. Take a look inside the Industrimu-seet Frederiks Værk, where you can enjoy changing historical exhibitions and an excellent museum shop. Frederiksværk Handel (local business association) ensures the streets are always full of life with concerts, Cannonball Friday and activities during public and school holidays.
